Welcome Sailors and Parents!

Shrewsbury Sailing & Yacht Club's Junior Sailing Program has been teaching young people the joy of sailing in an atmosphere that promotes seamanship, sportsmanship and fun for almost 60 years. Whether you are new to sailing or an experienced skipper, there is no better place to spend the summer than at SSYC!

This year we're changing Beginner lessons to mornings only – to allow our beginner sailors to take advantage of the lighter winds typically found in the mornings on the Shrewsbury River, to increase their time on the water. Intermediate lessons will be afternoons only and will allow our intermediate sailors to gain experience on the water and to minimize “no wind” conditions. We will continue to offer ½ day classes on Friday in response to requests for more lesson time, as well as intermediate Mini-Camp. Our fees have increased only slightly, once again.

Highlights include:

INTRODUCTION TO SAILING - Mini-Camp

Jun 28 to Jul 2, 2010 8:30 to NOON OR 1:00 to 4:30

Our extremely popular 5-day camp introduces novices to sailing in a fun and non-threatening manner. It is open to beginners, ages 8 and up, with no more than 2 years of lessons. It concludes with a **barbecue on Friday, Jul 2 at 6:00pm** where sailors can show off their new skills! Sailors may choose to take this camp alone **or** continue through one of our summer sessions.

INTERMEDIATE AND ADVANCED - Mini-Camp

Jun 28 to Jul 2, 2010 8:30 to NOON OR 1:00 to 4:30

This 5-day camp is designed for intermediate and advanced sailors to get sailors ready for regattas and the racing season. It concludes with a **barbecue on Friday, Jul 2 at 6:00pm** where sailors can show off their new skills! Sailors may choose to take this camp alone **or** continue through one of our summer sessions.

SUMMER SESSION

Jun 28 to Aug 20, 2009 (No classes July 5th, or August 9 through August 13th (unless sailor participates in the Jr. Sweepstakes Regatta August 9th through August 12th held locally on the Shrewsbury and Navesink Rivers)

Beginner lessons, intermediate, advanced, and racing – SSYC has a program for your sailor. The Summer Session concludes with a **barbecue on Friday, Aug 20 at 6:00pm**. Take a look at the enclosed schedule to find the session that fits your skill level.

MANDATORY ORIENTATION

There is again a mandatory orientation meeting for new sailors and parents or guardians on **EITHER June 24th at 7:00pm or June 26th at 10:00am** at the clubhouse, Oneida and Seawaneka Avenue, Oceanport. One parent or guardian must attend one session with the sailor. This is a great opportunity to ask questions, learn what you need to do as a parent/guardian, learn what we expect of you as a sailor and see what the summer holds for everyone!

SSYC Privacy Notice

Beginning in 2009 we will offer payment of your Club expenses by credit card (Visa, MasterCard and Discover Card). We will not be using card readers but instead we will be entering the required information directly into our QuickBooks On-line accounting system. That means the credit card does not need to be physically present to authorize the transaction. Instead, the information is obtained from you by mail-in-form or phone. Required information for processing includes your member name and address, the name on the card and card number, the billing address for the card and the expiration date including the four digit security number or CVV. You can assume this information will be noted prior to entry into QuickBooks. Much of this information is required by the merchant banking arm of QuickBooks to process a verification check against the card issuer's records and to safeguard against fraudulent use.

We will use this information once and only once. When the transaction is completed through QuickBooks the paper record of your card details will be shredded. We will not save this information for future transactions. As a result, you will need to submit this data each time you use a credit card at the Club.

Access to QuickBooks is limited to three trained and authorized members of the Board of Governors who are tasked with protecting your privacy and processing all financial information for the Club. These people comprise the Financial Committee and include the Treasurer, Financial Secretary, and Junior Program Financial Officer. Finally, we will not share any of your personal information with third parties under any circumstances. Our objective is to provide you with the peace of mind knowing that the security of your personal information is a top priority.
